A Running Record has a relevance span of about three weeks. For an accurate picture of a student ' s reading, Running Records should be taken on a passage of text with 100-150 words or the entire text if less than that. Scoring. Running Records are scored and a conversion rate is used to calculate a percentage accuracy score.

Once you do the first running record, the time in between running records will depend on how well the child is progressing and what level they are reading. An emergent reader (using Reading A to Z levels aa – C, for example) will be assessed every two to four weeks, while a fluent reader (level Q – Z) should be assessed every eight to 10 weeks.

What Are Running Records? A Teacher Guide for Planning ...
It takes World Record performances for each age and distance, for men and women, and uses these as benchmarks. So, for example: if the World Record for a 40 year old man running 10 miles is 46:31 and another 40 year old man runs 10 miles in 58:30, he has an Age-Graded performance of 79.5% (46:31 divided by 58:30).
